1. TITLE OF THE PROPOSAL:

2. BACKGROUND

The MoH has set standards for proper health care services delivery; these standards are for diagnostic, curative, nursing, preventive, promotive and rehabilitative health care. By using these set standards, the quality of health care will improve. The District Council had been trying to provide services as per set standards to its health facilities

3.1 PROBLEM ANALYSIS:

- Unavailability of set guidelines at service delivery points on:
 - i. Malaria Management
 - ii. Obstetric Care
 - iii. Diabetes Mellitus
 - iv. Mental Health

- Inadequate continuing education to Health Workers,
- Inadequate supervision skills,
- Inadequate medical Equipments at health delivery points.

3.2 PROBLEM STATEMENT:

Inadequate adherence to set standards for management of Common diseases among health service providers in Kwimba District.

4. JUSTIFICATION:

In order to improve quality of health care by using set standard guidelines, the district has planned to do the following:

- Prepare and distribute set standard guidelines for common diseases in Kwimba District
- Training on supervision skills and standard guidelines to 18 Health management team and 94 HSP

5.1. BROAD OBJECTIVE:-

To improve knowledge and skills to health workers in adherence to set standards and provision of quality of care in Kwimba district by December 2005.

5.2. SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES:

- To improve availability of set standard guidelines to all 37 health facilities in Kwimba District by December 2005.
- To improve knowledge and skills to Health service providers on set standards for common diseases in Kwimba District by the end of December 2005.
- To strengthen Supportive Supervision, Monitoring and Evaluation in provision of quality health care.

5.3. OUTPUT

- Gap between MOH and HF's level regarding availability of different guideline known
- Different guidelines at all health facilities available
- 122 HSPs trained through On job supportive supervision
